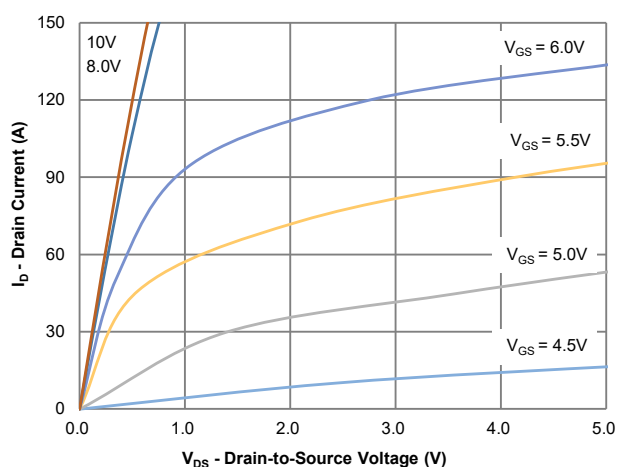


Figure 1: Output Characteristics

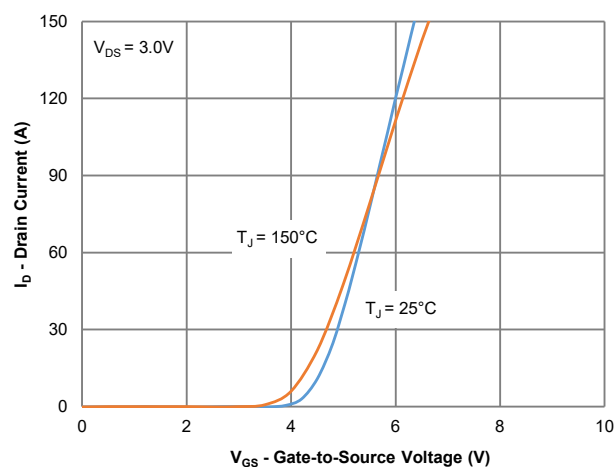


Figure 2: Transfer Characteristics

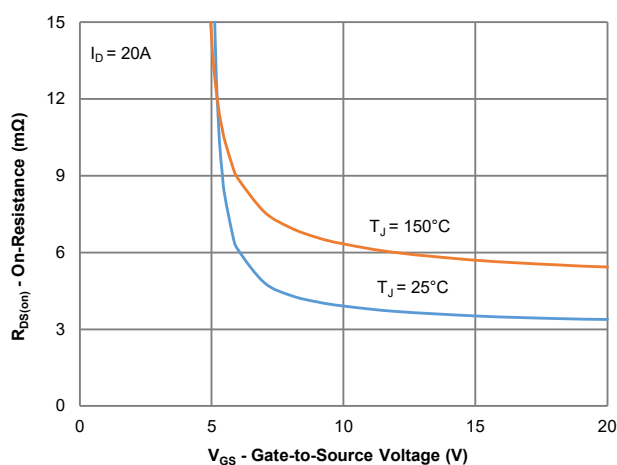


Figure 3: On-Resistance vs. Gate-Source Voltage

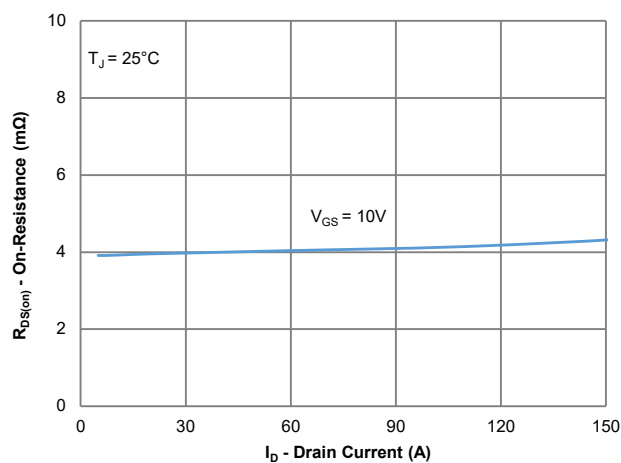


Figure 4: On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage

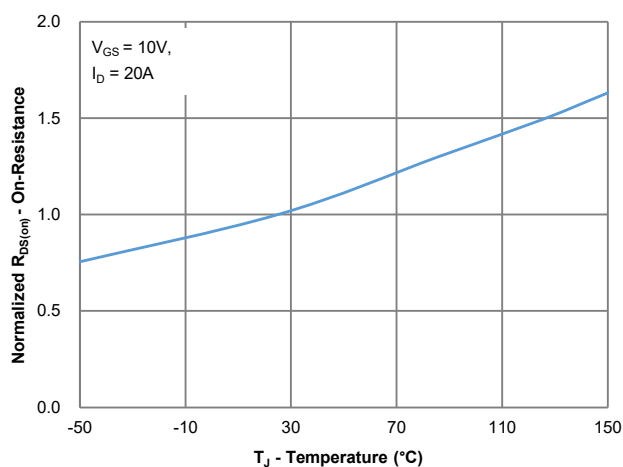


Figure 5: On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature

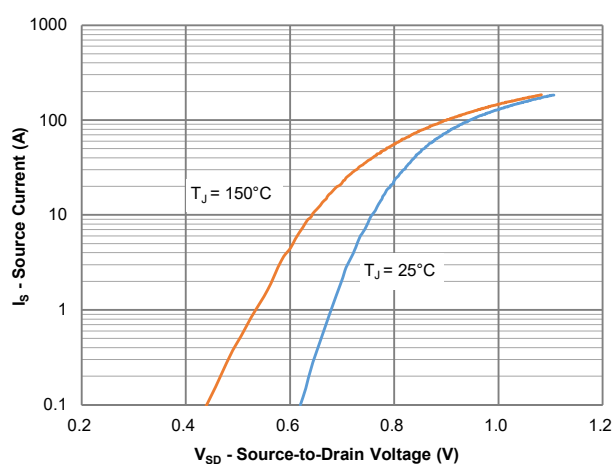
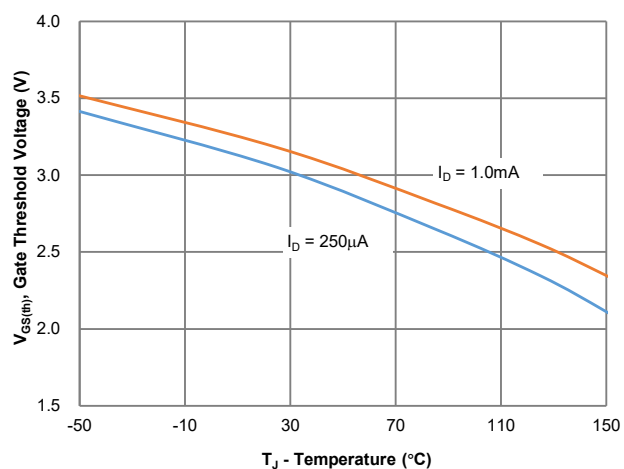
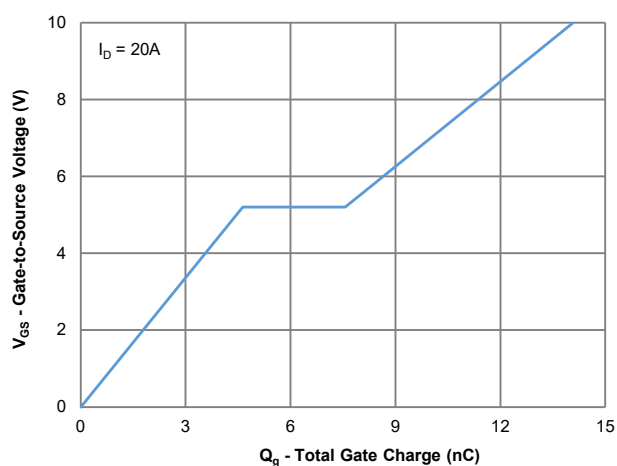
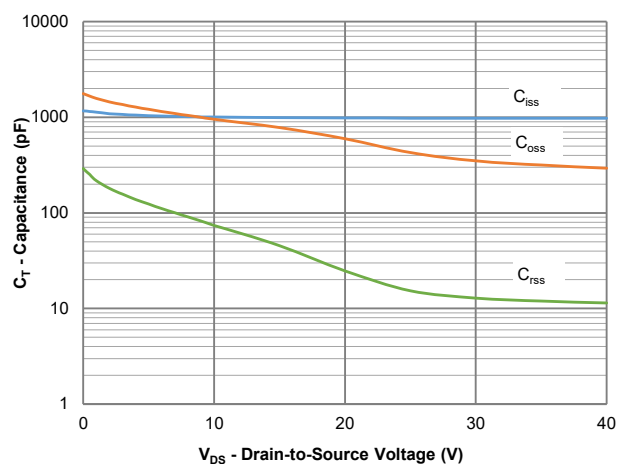
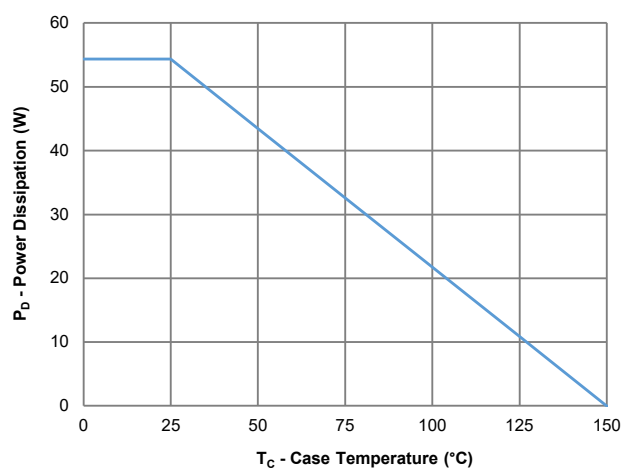
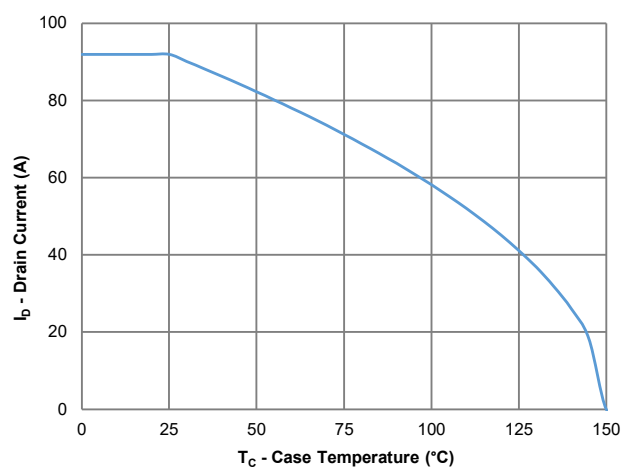
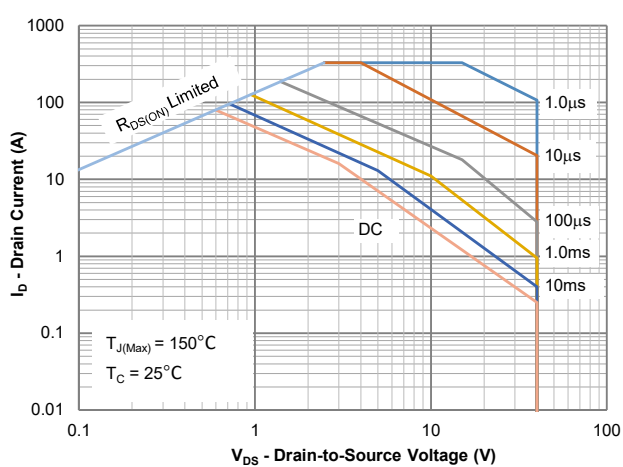
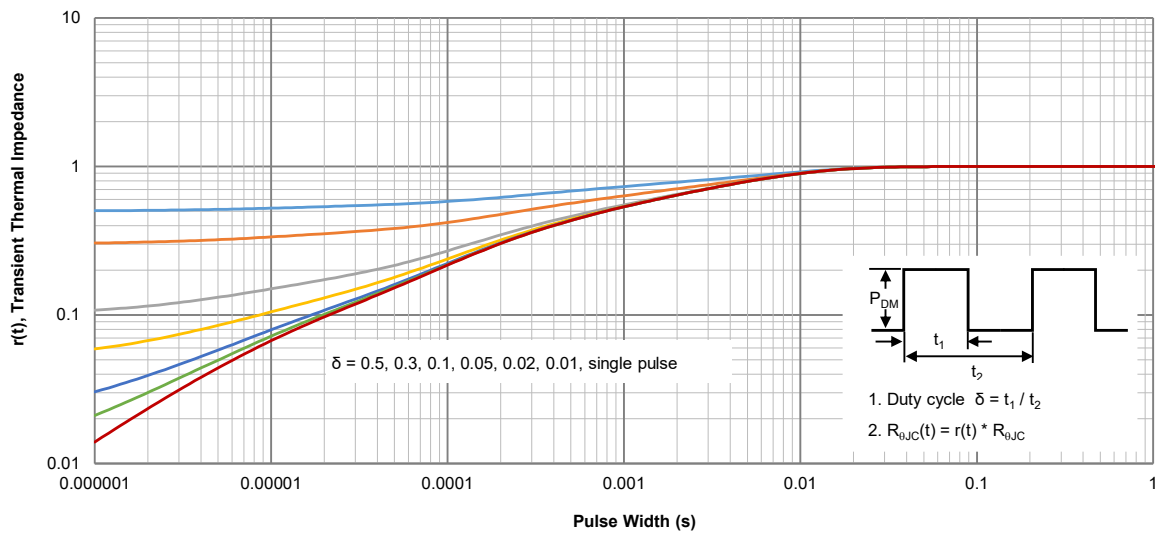
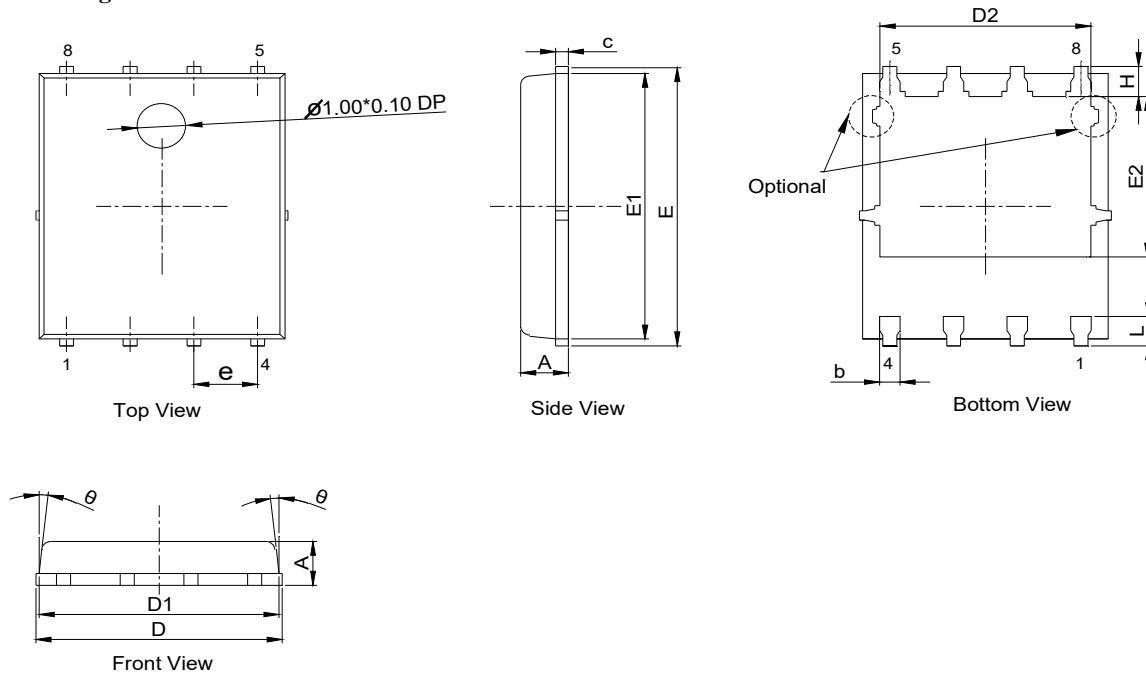


Figure 6: Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage

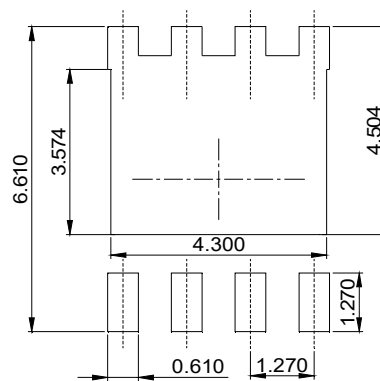
